59. Picnic in the Park 2011 – Sunday 7 August 2011

Members were advised a junior and senior rounder's tournament would be organised by Baysgarth Leisure Centre. Councillor Mr J Oxley had organised trophies for both tournaments and medals for the children's races. The Co-op supermarket in Barton had sponsored the races with a £100, a letter of thanks had been sent and their details would be mentioned in any publicity for the event.

Minutes of Community Regeneration Committee held on 20 June 2011, cont'd

All paperwork completed for hire of Baysgarth Park, North Lincolnshire Council PEG Group form completed, they have agreed event is acceptable if run as explained on the form. Football pitches booked for rounders, race track to be marked out and sweets for all race entrants to be sorted. Police will be in attendance, St Johns Ambulance will provide 1st aid cover for £100.00. Barton Town Community Band donation of £100.00, Julia Tyson Dance School donation of £50.00, North Lincolnshire Council Sports Coaches no charge and Batons of Steel donation of £50.00 all attending, along with Barton Lions catering unit. Barton Army Cadets hoping to attend. Lindsey Relay can provide pa system and caravan.

The Knotted Note can provide face painting and a treasure trail for £300, they also want to bring bikes for people to try out, rabbits/chickens in cages for show/pet and information/advice for cv building and interview tips. It was agreed to get alternative prices for face painting, Councillors Ms C Sansam & S Dear to provide contact details to the Council office, the chairman and Council office to arrange face painting with the most cost effective group up to a maximum of £300. It was also agreed bikes and pets would not be suitable as they have not been included in the PEG Group application and have an element of risk, also cv information was not something for a children's picnic.

Prices had also been obtained for a craft workshop by The Ropewalk 1 activity with 1 artist at £150; magic show by Mr Shiney £250.00 for 3 shows; coconut shy with 100 coconuts £100.00, additional attractions could also be provided from the same contractor if funds would allow. Pedro the Clown, Nutty Norman and Phoenix Eye Kickboxing are unable to attend, Barton Town Cricket Club and fire engine no reply to date. Three prices received and opened in the meeting for the ice cream van concession at £30.00, £100.00 & £135.00. It was agreed to accept the prices from The Ropewalk, Mr Shiney and coconut shy along with Brackenbury's ice cream concession at £135.00. Following notification from Barton Rotary Club that they would sponsor an additional attraction up to £300 a price for a circus workshop was requested. The price had increased by £100 from 2010 to £450.00, it was agreed this was too expensive and to leave out this attraction. The Rotary Club to be requested to sponsor the face painting as an alternative. Prices to be obtained from the coconut shy contractor for his additional attractions which should be booked if within budget.

Leaflets when produced to be distributed to Barton Primary Schools, and by Councillors M Martin and A Searle to tourist attractions in Barton and nurseries, respectively.

Additional attractions to attend were suggested as John Turner Karate Club, skateboard ramps from North Lincolnshire Council or Barton Youth Centre. Councillor Searle to enquiry about the skateboard ramps, along with a Lifestyle team to assist with the races.

It was also agreed the town council should look to have a policy for the inclusion of children with disabilities for this event.

Resolved that:-

- (i) Prices from The Ropewalk, Mr Shiney and coconut shy activities to be accepted;
- (ii) The ice cream concession at £135.00 to be accepted;
- (iii) A circus workshop not to be booked;
- (iv) Alternative face painting prices to be looked into and the most cost effective booked;
- (v) Additional attractions to be booked from coconut shy contractor, if within budget;
- (vi) Additional attractions without cost, for skateboard ramps and karate to be arranged if possible;
- (vii) Councillors A Todd, Mr and Mrs Oxley, A Searle, P Adams, M Martin, Ms C Sansam, F Coulsey, Mrs Witter and S Dear along with Mr D Witter, the town clerk and deputy town clerk would be available to help out at the event.

60. Barton Christmas Festival – Saturday 26 November 2011

Members discussed arrangements to date for Barton Christmas Festival. The Premises Licence application has been sent to North Lincolnshire Council and would be publicly advertised in the local paper. The cost for this had increased and would be £37.00 over budget.

The road closure request, PEG group application plus highway permission for the festive lighting are still to be organised. The office has been contacted by the Potty Pantos, Strictly Dance Group and BADAOS who would all like to take part again this year. The Ropewalk are able to arrange a Lantern Parade, the theme is to be decided. Barton Chamber of Trade to be requested to join in the event and organise a shop window competition. Craft and Charity stalls to be arranged soon, along with contacting the Salvation Army. The owner of the ex Local Link office on the High street to be contacted as soon as possible to ensure the Christmas tree can be erected again this year. New entertainment was discussed and Councillors M Martin and Ms C Sansam would make enquiries for acoustic guitars and open mic sessions, respectively for the stage and advise the council office. Attracting more community groups to the community parade competition would be looked at by Councillor A Searle. Christmas Plus, the festive lighting contractor, would be supplying an up to date inventory of our Christmas lights.

Resolved that all the above suggestions to be accepted, for further report at the next meeting of this Committee on Monday 19 September 2011.

61. Queens Diamond Jubilee in 2012

Members were advised the Barton Senior Alliance had enquired if Barton would be taking part in any celebrations for the Queens Diamond Jubilee from 2 – 5 June 2012. It was noted that a fundraising committee had been formed for the Silver Jubilee, and the picnic in the park was moved forward for the Golden Jubilee. It was agreed to enquire with other local groups such as, Barton Lions, Rotary, Arts Week, Tourism, Senior Alliance and Schools Forum if they would be organising any events. The same dates in June 2011 had been Barton Beer Festival. It was agreed that the town council in principle supports the co-ordination of events for the Queens Diamond Jubilee in June 2012 and they would discuss this matter further at the next meeting of this committee on Monday 19 September 2011 when it should be known what other groups intend to arrange and possibly form a sub-committee. Mrs J Tuplin would put an enquiry on the new Barton website if any groups are planning to organise an event.

Resolved that Barton town council in principle supports the co-ordination of events for the Queens Diamond Jubilee in June 2012 and they would discuss this matter further at the next meeting of this committee on Monday 19 September 2011
