212. Declarations of Interest

No declarations of interest were made at this meeting

213. Adjourned Meeting

The Chairman sought resolution from members present, for standing orders to be temporarily suspended whilst a local resident spoke about proposals for planning application PA/2014/1360.

Resolved agreed by members present.

The local resident commented that the location of the proposed development site was not land designated for housing - it was for industrial use. Also, that the land is very wet and marshy land. She felt that no commercial operations such as the nursery proposals etc. are required on the site.

The Chairman, Councillor Mrs Witter, thanked the resident for her comments and re-opened the meeting.

214. Planning Matters

(a) **<u>Planning Applications</u>**

<u>Resolved</u> that the comments as stated, be made to North Lincolnshire Council on the following Planning Applications:

(1) PA/2014/1360 – Wren Living – Planning permission to erect 300 dwellings, a small commercial development incorporating a 50 bed hotel, 50 place day nursery and small supermarket, a total of 16 fishing lodges set within 11.42ha of public open space at Falklands Way, Barton (it was agreed by members present, to apply to North Lincolnshire Planning Department for an extension of time to comment on the application, due to the applicant and its' consultants holding a public consultation on the 8 January 2015 regarding the proposals. It was felt this gave local residents and members of the public to have better insight into the planning proposals. Once this had been concluded, these comments could be incorporated into the town council's response. The comments received to date by the town council include the following: fully supportive of the application with much needed employment for the town. Concerns regarding the strain on the current health centres in the town, requesting that another health centre be incorporated into the development plans to accommodate the additional local residents. Young people wishing to have indoor and outdoor activities. Polarised public opinions with concern regarding the supermarket and quality of the housing, but support for the hotel. Concern regarding the development site not being in the local housing development area. A good development for the town, but concern

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regarding the infrastructure and demand placed upon the existing sewage and drainage systems. Positive feedback regarding site employment and relocation of employees moving into the town. An increase in the town's population would be good. Traffic concerns – with the site entrance onto Barrow Road queried. The wet and soggy nature of the development site questioned. Section 106 agreements and the incorporation of playground areas queried. As the land was designated for industrial use, this will affect the balance of provision not only in North Lincolnshire, but also the Humber Region. The access to the fishing lodges queried. The hotel did not appear to have an internal site access to Wren Living. Medical provision was queried, together with sewage and surface water issues. School allocations were queried together with site access regarding refuse collection. Assessment of the local plan and land/housing allocations would need to be considered. The Barton Civic Society have a meeting planned to be held on 9 January, to debate the possibility of a road being built at the top of Falkland Way through to Caistor Road, to ease possible traffic issues, particularly through the town centre. It was agreed that the planning application be commented upon at the next town council Planning Committee meeting to be held on 26 January 2015 - subject to confirmation with North Lincolnshire Planning Department for the extension of time to make comment):

- (2) <u>PA/2014/1280 Howe Renovation (Yorks) Ltd (Mr Anthony Richard Howe)</u> Planning permission to erect restriction barriers at White Hart House, Brigg Road, Barton (Comment: the town council are unable to comment upon boundary disputes and business competition)
- (3) <u>PA/2014/ 1281 Howe Renovation (Yorks) Ltd (Mr Anthony Richard Howe)</u> Planning permission to retain cctv cameras on poles at White Hart House, Brigg Road, Barton (Comment: the town council are unable to comment upon boundary disputes and business competition).
