Also, concern for overlooking issues from the properties themselves);
- (5) <u>PA/2018/1076 Smith & Walker (Mr Ralph Worfolk)</u> Planning permission to erect an extension and alterations to the rear of the premises at 16 High Street, Barton (No comment or objection);
