(a) **Planning Applications**

- (1) **PA/2019/820 – Mr Rodney Clapson** – Notice of intention to prune a Mulberry tree within Barton-upon-Humber's conservation area at 16 Whitecross Street, Barton (Comment: the town council are pleased to see applications to prune trees instead of removing them);
- (2) **PA/2019/1189 – Mr George Turner** – Planning permission to erect a single-storey rear extension, demolish existing garage and replace with new attached garage at 1 Warrendale, Barton (No comment or objection);
- (3) **PA/2019/1224 – Mr William Eggleton** – Planning permission to erect a rear extension at 55 Westfield Road, Barton (No comment or objection);
