(a) **Planning Applications**

Resolved that the comments as stated, be made to North Lincolnshire Council on the following Planning Applications:

- (1) **PA/2019/1404 – West Town Surgery (Dr Uzma Khan)** – Listed building consent to replace two windows at 80 High Street, Barton (No comment or objection);
- (2) **PA/2019/1403 – Heron Foods Limited (Mr Paul Stubbley)** – Advertisement consent to display three illuminated fascia signs at the old Lidl Supermarket, High Street, Barton (Objection: light pollution issues in a residential area. The signage to either be replaced with external non illuminated, or if in-store, to be on a timer that switches off when the store closes each day);
- (3) **PA/2019/1528 – Mr K Marson** – Advertisement consent for three illuminated fascia signs at High Street, Barton (Objection: light pollution issues in a residential area. The signage to either be replaced with external non illuminated, or if in-store, to be on a timer that switches off when the store closes each day);
- (4) **PA/2019/1493 – Mr Mark Thompson** – Application to fell an Ash tree identified as T13 in and subject to Tree Preservation (Barton-upon-Humber) Order 1989 at 24 Pasture Road South, Barton (Objection: it is felt that reducing the tree to a safe height would be the best option to take. Particularly as the tree has a Tree Preservation Order upon it and for environmental reasons).
