1. Chairman Welcome and Introductions

Chairman welcomed all members to the meeting.

3. Consultation update – updates in response to prior consultation

JW has been collating the results of the survey. The feedback and comments are being fed into updating the Neighbourhood Plan. Further results in the Town Council Office to be forwarded to JW. Some of the comments are around the lack of visitor accommodation and cycle paths as well as low traffic neighbourhoods and flooding. It was suggested that there should be more discussion about the lack of parking and it was questioned as to why buildings are not purchased to make way for more parking space. JW explained that there often is the aspiration to provide more parking spaces

reducing the dependency on the need for cars and the Plan could allocate sites for car parking. Needs would need to be viable and realistic, however they could be contentious. JW would not recommend this would be right pathway to take within the Neighbourhood Plan and the wrong message could be sent. Cllr Jacques commented on the fact that once the Interchange plans are moved forward there will be Long Stay parking there leaving the ability to create 2 hourly free parking within the town centre and then car movement would be greater. He went on to sat that reduction of car dependency should be encouraged. Mr Lawless said that the timings for the improvements to the Interchange have not yet been revealed. It was suggested that in other places temporary car parks have been created on areas where development is delayed. LB stated that businesses could liaise with local pubs and ask to use their car parks during the day that are often empty. There may be other small practical ways to alleviate the car parking issues. JW stated that the Neighbourhood Plan could identity the need for Long Stay, Medium Stay and Short Stay car parks. It was also suggested that one way systems again could be suggested but these are not in the remit of a Neighbourhood Plan. Cllr Jacques explained the current suggestions from North Lincolnshire Highways for a one way system to be put in place on Hungate. He expressed his opinion that this should be one way exiting from the town.

4. Presentation of on-going work on the Design Code to include examples

JW presented the work that he has completed so far. Some of the Extensive Urban Survey work has been used in the building of each character area. Each character area has been colour coded with a high level of description. The North Lincolnshire Council Conservation Area Report is currently out of date.

JW will email draft to the Town Clerk for distribution and welcomes all additions and help to assist with completion of the Design Code work.

5. Visioning for the Design Code – JW

Visioning for the Design Codes to be on the January agenda.

6. Update on Heritage Work

LB has begun this work and completed one aspect but would like the advice from JW before continuing. There is a group meeting next week and a list of the sites will be emailed to JW. There are over 100 sites that have been identified and eight group members.
